



Red Wine 2019

Alentejo Region

Concept: A wine for all occasions. With a balanced and gastronomic profile, it portrays the best bouquets and flavours of Alentejo grapes.

Harvest Year: The 2019 agricultural year recorded temperatures corresponding to the average for the last 20 years, while the recorded rainfall values were below the average values for the same period. In the spring and up until the beginning of the summer, temperatures were higher than in 2018, which led to a considerable advance in the phenology of the vine, translating into the anticipation of the harvest in about 2 weeks, compared to 2018. The summer registered lower temperatures in the veraison phase, promoting a constant and homogeneous ripening process, ideal conditions for a raw material of excellent quality.

Viticulture: Soil Geology: granitic/schistose nature, open clay structure. Average Age of the Vineyards: 18 years.

Varieties: Aragonez, Trincadeira, Touriga Nacional and Syrah

Vinification: Stemming, crushing, fermentation in stainless steel tanks with controlled temperatures, pressing, malo-lactic fermentation, 3 months minimum ageing in stainless steel.

Bottling: February 2020
